Before the dance:

 Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525) of any needed changes to assigned dates.

- The designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:15 PM and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with key access will open the gates and will secure the hall at end of evening.
- Check the restrooms for supplies & tidiness.
- Because of COVID we will not be providing drinks.
 Single serving commercially made & wrapped snacks are welcomed.
- In the hall, set up one table for signing in and another for snacks. One unopened table needs to go in front of the piano. Flyers can go onto the top of the freezer.
- Place hand sanitizer on sign-in and snack table and at front of hall and at each round table.
- Set up the easel & board to receive the birthday/ anniversary dates provided by the Treasurer.

During Club dance:

- Welcome everyone as they enter.
- Collect a **\$8.00** donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests check the prepared guest sheet, new guests sign the guest book.
- In the green box, there is an envelope with \$70 petty cash for making change.
- Check the member sign-in list to see if we have any members on LOA. Those on LOA who will be dancing pay our Guest Donation of \$8.00.
- Offer 50/50 raffle tickets: 5 tickets for \$1.00.
- In the green box, there are Square Head envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club and 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance EXCEPT for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) after which you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up
- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.

After the dance:

- Pack up the sign-in table items & give to Steph.
- Reset the hall to the way we found it.
- Notify Stephanie and Naomi if we need more Club event flyers or Chirpers printed for the following week.



Hi Friends

Just got home from Kaiser.

I believe I will easily be able to call all future dance commitments. AND book additional dances if folk want me.

It seems the BIG OLE SHOT IN MY BUTT is the extent of what will happen to me at least for a while.

One of the major things noticeable when investigating Prostate Cancer is OVER DIAGNOSIS.

Due to the preliminary tests Kaiser was quite sure I had Prostate Cancer (May), & Kaiser says about 80% of men over 60 that live in the USA do (the web says MOST worldwide).

Cancer is in my prostate & lymph nodes near my prostate. Damn weeds! and it is not politically correct to use RoundUp anymore for weeds.

Testing & scans have proved it is NOT in my bones, brain, colon, rectum, or lungs. I will take THAT!

FYI: I have had NO, ZERO, NADA days feeling BAD due to cancer symptoms EVER. Any dances I missed since May revolved around tests & immediate test process side effects for THAT day. OR Joann's late afternoon medical stuff (rescheduled to accommodate ME getting prompt testing/scans)(though I cannot quite equate May to mid-August as Prompt).

It has been about a month since I got the first hormone (testosterone) suppression shot in my butt. PSA evaluated August 15 --> PSA is now 12. That much of a reduction was unexpected. Side effects are HOT FLASHES, Fatigue & getting pissed off easily. HOT FLASHES & Fatigue seem to be here along with PSA reduction. Have not YELLED at dancers yet & I have not YET asked any

ladies for a referral to where BEST to get hair & nails done. I hope testosterone does NOT fade THAT far.

Maybe a REALLY good indication is Kaiser is telling me to make certain followup appointments in 2027.

Fatigue IS closing in from a day starting with Stress & Anxiety. Time for an OGN (Old Guy Nap).
